STRAWBERRY FARMS GOLF CLUB

1. The first rule is: Golf is a game and games are supposed to be **FUN**. Remember, this is not the final round in the U.S. Open.
2. The second rule is even simpler: Play your ball where you hit it. Naturally, all rules have exceptions. If, for whatever reason, you are not physically or mentally able to hit your ball where it lies, your ball may be moved within 10 feet to a point where it can be physically and mentally hit. This counts as one (1) stroke.
3. The course is in great shape, and summer rules will apply. **SUMMER RULES** are that you hit the ball where it lies. Gentlemen will play from the **WHITE** tees and ladies will play from the **RED** tees.
4. The object of the game is to hit the ball into the respective cup. However, a golf ball coming to rest within 12 inches of the respective cup shall be considered "**makeable**" and counted as one stroke. This is commonly known as a "**gimmie**".
5. Maximum score on a PAR 5 hole will be 11, a PAR 4 hole 9 and a PAR 3 hole 7. You may shoot a score higher than this, but please record only these scores on the scorecard. The individual listed first on the scorecard is the captain. The captain is responsible for checking scores and totals and turning the scorecards into the registration table within 15 minutes of finish.
6. The golf course has a strict dress code: **No T-shirts, tank tops, jeans, or cargo shorts. The Country Club is a non-metal spike facility.**
7. Closest to Pin contest on all PAR 3's. Long Drive Contest on Holes 4 and 12.
8. Las Vegas Opportunity Drawing on Holes 7 and 15 – **Over \$5,000 in prizes!**
9. The last rule is: **HAVE FUN !!!**
