## WATER DISTRIBUTION OPERATOR I

**Must possess a State of California Department of Health Services Water Distribution Operator Grade D2 certificate and obtain Grade D3 within probationary period.**

**THE WATER DISTRIBUTION OPERATOR I** is an entry-level classification which performs unskilled, semi-skilled, or skilled labor in service activities of the Water Division of the Public Works Department, including water system maintenance, construction and repair; reading water meters and noting amounts used by customers for billing purposes; installing, replacing or repairing water main lines and services lines; performing maintenance on wet and dry style barrel fire hydrants; reading basic blueprints for marking of underground facilities; operating computerized water telemetry system; operating trucks, backhoes, tractors, front-end loaders, and heavy equipment; and performing related duties, as assigned. Work assignments may vary depending upon priority schedules and/or seasonal requirements. The Water Distribution Operator I is expected to work during normal time-off hours to assist with emergency repair or maintenance operations, as needed. In accordance with Government Code Section 3100, City employees, in the event of a disaster are considered disaster service workers and may be asked to respond accordingly.

Qualifications:

- Completion of high school or its equivalent and/or the completion of a trade or vocational school.
- Some directly related experience.
- Possession of a current Water Distribution Operator Grade D2 (or higher) certificate issued by the State of California Department of Health Services (must also obtain level Grade D3 prior to the completion of one year).
- Possession of a valid California Class C Driver's License; and, prior to the completion of one year of employment, possession of a valid Class A Driver's License.

**THE SELECTION PROCESS** shall consist of a non-weighted application review, a practical examination (weighted 50% of overall score), and for the highest scorers on the practical examination, an oral appraisal interview (weighted 50% of overall score). Candidates earning a minimum overall rating of 70% or higher shall have their names placed on the Employment Eligibility List for Water Distribution Operator I. Position openings will be filled from the Eligibility List. Eligibility Lists are generally used for up to one year.

**FILING DEADLINE:** Completed electronic employment applications and a copy of a Grade D2 (or higher) certificate will be accepted **until a sufficient number of qualified applications have been received**. Electronic employment application forms are available on-line at <https://jobs.cityofbrea.net>. Internet access is also available at many public

libraries. Resumes cannot be accepted in lieu of a City of Brea employment application; facsimiles and postmarks cannot be accepted. The City of Brea cannot accept responsibility for notifying candidates of incomplete applications. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure the application and Grade D2 (or higher) certificate are submitted.
